PILGRIMAGE ON THE CAMINO DE SANTIAGO

1. You write about your pilgrimage on the *Camino de Santiago*. What is the *Camino de Santiago*?
2. Why did you make a pilgrimage on the Camino de Santiago?
3. Did you find what you were looking for?
4. What else did you find? What did you learn on your pilgrimage?
5. Does someone have to go to such extremes as to walk a pilgrimage to learn what you did? What if they don't have the time or interest in doing that? What can they do?
6. Why did you write your book, *Keep Walking . . . Your Heart Will Catch Up*?
7. What message do you hope readers will get from your book?

GRIEF AND LOSS

8. Let's talk a moment about grief. After your husband's death, you say you didn't feel the grief until three years later. It caught you by surprise. Tell us about that.
9. What do you say to someone who is experiencing loss? The loss of a loved one, a dream, a job, etc.
10. What have you learned about yourself since your husband passed away?
11. How do you find hope in the middle of despair and loss?
12. Have you found new love since you were widowed?

14. How do you "hear" God? How do you know he's talking to you?
15. Can you give an example of one of your conversations? What does God say to you?
